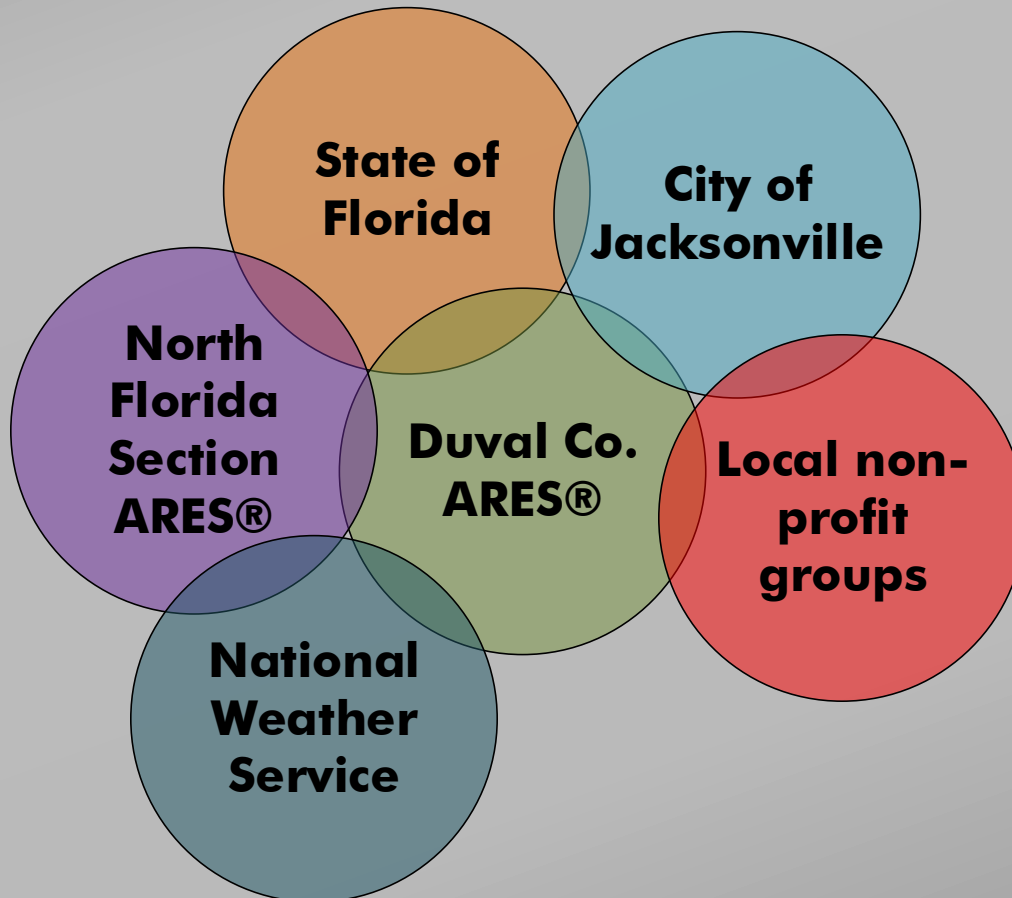

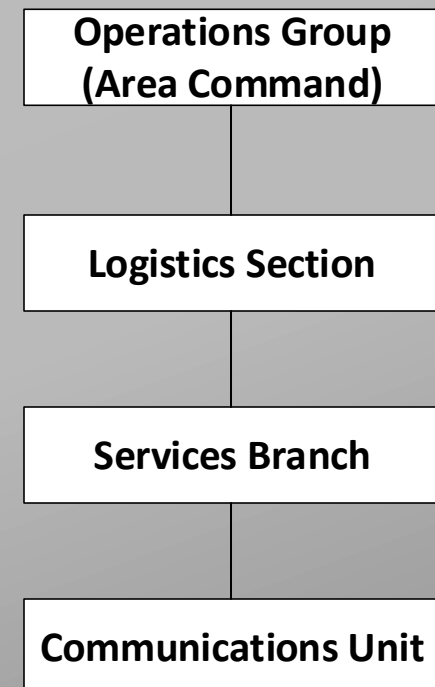

## Communications Unit

### Emergency Communications Plan

- Protocols and procedures for establishing and maintaining radio, telephone, and internet communications prior to, during and following a catastrophic event
- Activated by the Emergency Manager
- Upon activation, agencies responsible for this operational plan will activate their individual plans of operation for their respective agency and responsibilities within the operational plan
- Activation of this operational plan will also initiate notification of the ARES® operators to respond to the EOC or designated Area Command location
- ARES® operators can provide communications support to the Area Commander as a secondary and/or back-up to the primary radio communication system

## **Supporting agency responsibilities**

- **Provide appropriate personnel, equipment, facilities, technical assistance, and other support as required, in order to assist the lead agency**
- **Provide technical and subject-matter expertise, data, advice, and staff support for operations that fall within the domain of the agency**
- **Assist the lead agency in staffing the EOC, as needed**
- **Maintain and review applicable operational plans and position checklists to allow for the efficient and effective implementation of the missions**
- **Train agency staff responsible for implementing the City of Jacksonville CEMP, Operational Plans, and position checklists**
